



Two Brothers Plumbing & Heating Ltd. Fire Evacuation Procedure

Upon discovery of smoke or fire,

1. Turn off power tools, appliances or motors.
2. Pull fire alarm pull station.
3. Use Fire Extinguisher if trained to do so. Do not fight fire alone, and evacuate immediately if you cannot extinguish it safely.
4. Evacuate to a safe area away from the building. Do not use Elevators. Follow exit signs and stairways out of building.
5. **Call 911****
6. Give details of incident to building representative, medical aid, fire rescue and/or law enforcement
7. Remain a safe distance from the building until directed to by emergency personnel or security that it safe to re-enter the building.

Fire Extinguisher Type Designations:

Type Category Use on following fire types

1. Water Class A (combustible Solids) Wood, Cloth, Plastics, Paper
 2. Foam Class B (flammable Liquids) Petrol, Oil, Paint
 3. CO2 Class C (flammable Gases) Methane, Propane, Butane, Electrical equipment
 4. Dry chemical Class D (combustible Metals) Magnesium, Aluminium
 5. Dry chemical Class E (combustible Solids)
- All Class A, B and C fires (flammable liquids)
